PRECAUTIONARY/ISOLATION GOWN - YELLOW

MATERIALS NEEDED:

2 yards **yellow** KONA cotton material- washed

- 1- 3/8" wide bias tape -- 30 " long
- 4- 15" ribbon for ties
- 2- stretchable elastic cuffs

Pattern for gown

Size: large

Time to make: 1 hour

INSTRUCTIONS: WORKS BEST IF A SERGER IS USED

- 1. Cut material on grain.
- 2. Attach one tie to the inside of the side seam and one to the outside seam before sewing. Place at 10" from bottom of armhole.
- 3. Place the other two ties on the outside of the gown in the side seams at waist.
- 4. Sew both fronts to back section with ties in position.
- 5. Attach folded side of sleeve to bottom of arm hole of gown; sew the open sleeve to the armhole.

The shoulder of the gown and the sleeve are open at the top.

- 6. Sew each stretchable cuff to the sleeve.
- 7. Sew the shoulder and sleeve
- 8. With the bias tape, sew around the neck area of the gown.
- 9. Serge the bottom of the gown or put in a ½" hem.

Press gown.
